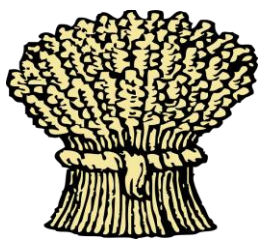


HARVEST AT ST MARY'S
